Health and Safety Information about our Mobile Shower and Toilet Units

Delivery

All units are towed to site and sited by our driver, who will ensure they are sited on a level site, usually at the designated position requested by the client.

The unit is secured by jack legs, one in each corner which makes the unit completely stable.

The unit will then be left on site for the designated time, unless attendance service has been requested.

Electricity

A 16 amp power supply is required for our unit: all the internal electrics run off a 12v battery* which is powered by the 16 amp supply through an inverter. In the event of a power cut the lights will continue to run off the battery.

*The LCD screen runs off the 240v supply, which is plugged into the service area at the back of the unit. This cannot be unplugged inside the unit and the cable is run into the fabric of the unit, therefore there is no trip hazard with trailing cables. This will not run if there is a power cut. The service area is a locked compartment at the back of the unit.

Each unit is tested on an annual basis for electrical safety and certificates can be viewed.

Chemicals

A bleach free chemical called Blue by Safechem is used in our toilets. This is an environmentally friendly chemical. Coshh data sheet is available to view, along with the Coshh risk assessments.

The units are cleaned with a general household cleaner.

All units are supplied clean, if attended they will be cleaned throughout the hire. Upon return to base, a gully sucker is used to suck out the contents into a septic tank. The inside of the unit is then jet washed. It is then filled with clean water over the filters, then 1 litre of blue is added.

Soaps/Handwash

All our soaps and handwash are high quality products that have been thoroughly tested before use. They are not known to cause any allergic reactions.
